

Level 6 Award in Primary School Physical Education Subject Leadership

What is this qualification about?

The Level 6 Award in Primary School Physical Education Subject Leadership is a recognised qualification that aims to develop subject leader practice in primary schools in order to improve the sustainability of high quality physical education curriculum within primary schools.

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification builds on the learning of the Level 5 Certificate in Primary School Physical Education Specialism by engaging in how to lead sustainable development within primary school physical education. This includes understanding the roles and responsibilities of a physical education subject lead, being able to determine the quality of provision, and being able to design, lead the implementation of, review and revise a targeted strategy to develop primary school physical education and its sustainability.

What is the duration of the course?

The notional learning time is 20 hours. The guided learning hours are 18 and this equates to a 2 day tutored programme. The course programme can usually be completed over a period of 12 weeks due to the nature and scope of the assessment tasks.

Who is it suitable for?

The course is suitable for anyone who has Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) or General Teaching Council for Scotland (GTC) accreditation. You must also have successfully completed a Level 5 Certificate in Primary School Physical Education Specialism.

How can I be confident of quality?

The course will be delivered by a team of tutors, who have all had vast experience in delivering high quality teacher training in University environments. Many are nationally and internationally recognised. One of our tutors is Ofsted qualified and Andrew Frapwell who will lead the delivery was one of the Level 5/6 qualification authors.
